House Bill 118 - Request for Exemption of Non-Resident Tuition for Certain Foreign Nationals

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Application Deadlines

Request for House Bill 118 consideration must be submitted with all required documentation by the tuition payment deadline listed on the University of Utah's academic calendar (registrar.utah.edu/academic-calendars/).

Requirements

The Utah Board of Regents Policy R513-14 (higheredutah.org/policies/) states the following:

A student shall be exempt from paying the non-resident portion of total tuition if the student

- Is a foreign national legally admitted to the United States;
- Attended a Utah high school in Utah for three or more years; and
- Graduated from a Utah high school or received the equivalent of a high school diploma in Utah.

Procedures for Requesting Exemption from Non-Resident Tuition at the University of Utah

If you believe you qualify for the Utah House Bill 118 waiver of the non-resident portion of tuition, you must complete the following steps:

1. Complete and submit this request form by the tuition payment deadline for your admit term. **Handwritten signatures are required.** If you are approved to receive the House Bill 118 waiver, you will not need to reapply each term. You will continue to receive the waiver as long as you fulfill the requirements listed above or the University no longer offers this exemption.
 2. In addition to any credentials necessary for admissions to the University of Utah, submit official copies of a Utah high school transcript showing completion of at least three years in a Utah high school and proof that you have graduated from the Utah high school or have the equivalency of a high school diploma in Utah.
