Please note that consideration beyond one year requires the submission of a new application and application fee. **Only one deferment request per unique application will be processed.** This form may not be used to recommend a student to a different program- the submission of a new application and program-specific materials for that new program will be required.

To request a deferment, please complete the "Graduate Student Information" section with the student's information. Once all fields have been completed, please forward the form to the University of Utah Office of Admissions for processing by the first day of the original admit term.

By submitting this form, the department agrees to the following conditions and confirms that the information has been discussed with the student.

- Only deferment requests up to one year following the original term of admission will be considered.
- The deadline for the department to submit this form is the <u>first day of classes</u> of the student's original admit term. Late deferment requests will not be accepted.
- Once the deferment request has been approved, a deferment reversal to the student's original admit term will not be granted.
- Each student is entitled to a single deferment request. Subsequent deferrals will not be accepted and will require the student to reapply for a future term.

Students whose deferment requests have been approved will receive a formal letter from the Office of Admissions.
