Required documents to obtain a Utah license or identification card

- Double check that you have <u>all</u> the correct documentation before visiting a Driver License office.
- Documents must be an original or a copy certified by the issuing agency.
- ✓ Faxed or photocopied documents will NOT be accepted.
- Documents are subject to departmental review and approval. Additional information may be required.

If you have any questions regarding fees or appropriate documentation, please contact the Utah Driver License Division at 801.965.4437 or toll-free 888.353.4224 for assistance or visit <u>dld.utah.gov</u>.

- Any document not in English must be translated by a certified translator approved by the division and accompanied by the original.
- **Any name variation from your identity document <u>must</u> be accompanied by legal documentation authorizing the name change (marriage, divorce, or court order.)
- In some cases, document approval may not occur on the same day and may require an additional visit.
- All documents provided to the division will be imaged and stored in a secure database and will be returned to the applicant.
- Applicants 21 or over may request a "Veteran" indicator be added to their certificate by providing their DD214 or for WWII Veterans, a Record/Notice of Separation indication of an honorable discharge.

If you are a U.S. Citizen, U.S. National, or Permanent Resident Alien, <u>you must</u> <u>provide the following documentation</u> to obtain an **original** Utah License, Learner Permit, Identification Card, or Commercial Driver License.

IDENTITY LEGAL/LAWFUL STATUS VERIFICATION (must provide one)

- Valid, unexpired U.S. passport or passport card; or
- Certified copy of a birth certificate filed with the State Office of Vital Statistics or equivalent agency in the individual's state of birth (small laminated birth certificates or hospital certificates will not be accepted); or
- Consular Report of Birth Abroad (CRBA) issued by the U.S. Department of State, Form FS-240, DS-1350, or FS- 545; or
- Valid, unexpired Permanent Resident Card, Conditional Permanent Resident Card, Form I-551;
 or
- Certificate of Naturalization issued by DHS, Form N-550 or Form N-570; or
- Certificate of Citizenship, Form N-560 or Form N-561, issued by DHS.

**Any name variation from your identity document must be accompanied by legal documentation authorizing the name change (marriage, divorce, or court order.)

<u>- AND -</u>

UTAH RESIDENCY/MAILING VERIFICATION if different than current Utah driver license record

(must provide two) Must display the applicant's name and principal Utah residence address which may include:

- o Bank statement
- Court documents
- o Current mortgage or rental contract
- o Major credit card bill
- o Property tax notice
- School transcript
- Utility bill
- Vehicle title

Residency/mailing verification dated over 90 days may be reviewed by the division prior to acceptance.

<u>- AND -</u>

SOCIAL SECURITY VERIFICATION (must provide one)

- Social security card issued by the U.S. government that has been signed (stub will not be accepted); **or**
- If the social security card is not available, the applicant may present one of the following documents which contain the applicant's name and full social security number:
 - \circ W-2 form;
 - SSA-1099 form;
 - \circ Non SSA-1099 form;
 - Pay stub showing the applicant's name and <u>full</u> social security number; or
 - Letter from the Social Security Administration indicating ineligibility to obtain a social security number as a result of legal/lawful presence status.

<u>- AND -</u>

PROOF OF DRIVING EXPERIENCE

(required for first-time Utah driver license not required when obtaining a learner permit)

- Evidence of completion of a course in driver training; *or*
- Evidence of a driving privilege issued in another state or country.
